Advocacy and Public Awareness

- 1. UPDATE: Advocacy Agenda
 - Leah reached out to Regina and she agreed to go through the racial equity piece of the agenda
 - Create a workgroup that deals with racism, housing, and fair housing.
 - Leah will follow up with Regina with updates and also discuss with her how to structure the workgroup, the format, and what she recommends what the topics should be
- 2. Racial Disparities Grant
 - Second round of funding through Community Foundation
 - The grant amount is \$40,000 and is due August 17th.
 - Leah reached out to the foundation to see what area to apply under and she is waiting for a response
- 3. Functional Sentencing?
 - Reach out to Homeless and Poverty caucus to help with criminal justice reform as a part of advocacy
 - Elizabeth will reach out to Brenda and Rosemary regarding criminal justice and homelessness
 - a. ACLU lawsuit against OCJ
 - Access to basic hygiene items essential for COVID
 - Jail is targeting people who are impoverished
 - b. Impact of outstanding warrants on future resolution of homelessness
 - Outstanding warrants prevent people who are homeless, resolving homelessness
 - Have clients represented by street democracy or another organization to help clear up warrants
- 4. Plan for Homeless Awareness Month/November
 - a. Events for each week?
 - Add events to the community calendar. Ashley will look into creating a SPFAC calendar to share with everyone so we can organize PR for events.
 - Dave Woodward would like to create affordable housing workgroup through the board of commissioners and integrate this into homeless awareness.
 - Leah: Reach out to Shane to do an event based on first responders and law enforcement around homelessness.
 - Week of Veterans day: have event focused on veterans

- Week of Thanksgiving: share stories of families that just moved into housing
- Leah: reach out to MCAH and MSHDA if they have a certain week they like to target during the month
- b. What does planning and implementation look like?
 - Start planning as early as Sept.
 - Asking agencies what they plan to do to raise awareness during Homeless Awareness Month
 - Look at different CoC's for event ideas
 - Leah: send out to the list serve asking if other agencies are hosting an event in November so we can add to community calendar/ promote all the events happening through the Alliance.
 - Joe and Leah will help with planning

 - Registration will open August 15th

 - Host sites will be at Lighthouse and RO City Hall
